SchoolDocs is an online policy platform for schools in Aotearoa. Your SchoolDocs site contains policies and procedures that are specific to your school and can be accessed by the whole school community.

Using SchoolDocs

Log in to your SchoolDocs site using these details:

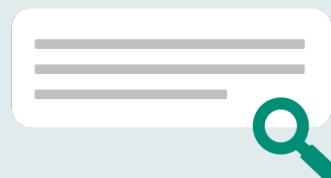
